

Add a Group Lesson!

Do you have children attending the party that have never skated before? For a minimum of 4 students you can request a half hour lesson with one of our skating professionals (based on availability, arrangements **MUST** be made in advance).

The fee is \$16 per student and includes the cost of the admission and skate rental during the session.

NOTE: Minimum of 4 guests must be paid for in full at time of application; additional guests may be added on the day of your party (make checks payable to M-NCPPC).

It's Party Time...

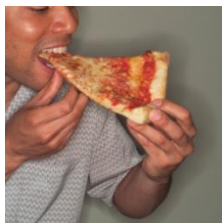
Planning a birthday party or celebration? Party rooms are available at Wheaton Ice Arena for birthday, office, holiday parties and more.

Have the coolest event or birthday party ever!!! Rent your very own room to have a wonderful party space.

\$50.00 an hour secures a private room with tables and chairs for up to 25 people (includes adults and children). Two rooms can be combined for **\$100.00 an hour** and a maximum of 50 people. Bring your own festive decorations for your special day (but please no confetti).

Food packages available:

- Pizza (16" / 8 slices)
 - Cheese: \$11.50
 - Pepperoni: \$13.00
- Soda (per pitcher): \$5.50



Take advantage of our **Group Discount Books** for groups of 10 or more. These books can be purchased at our front office and they never expire. Skate rentals are an additional fee unless you are attending a "Cheapskate" session.

NOTE: Room Rental Fee must be paid in full at time of application (make checks payable to M-NCPPC). Cancellations must be made a minimum of 2 weeks prior to your rental.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. When can I enter the party room and when must I leave?

You may enter the party room at the start of your contracted time. You must be ready to vacate the room at the end of your contracted time or you will incur additional costs.

2. Can I decorate?

Yes, but please no confetti. Please remember, however, you cannot enter the room before your contracted time. Therefore, if you would like to decorate early please rent the room accordingly.

3. Do you have candles and matches?

No, we do not have candles and matches. If you are bringing your cake from home, please make sure you remember the candles.

4. What about paper products?

Cups, plates, napkins, and eating utensils are provided by the facility with purchase of food. Paper products can also be purchased for a \$3.00 per place setting fee.

5. What time will my food be served?

Your food will be delivered to your room at the time you have requested. The rink staff cannot serve your guests, as they will be busy preparing and delivering food to several parties. Each public session runs for about two (2) hours. There is generally a 15 minute Zamboni break (intermission) half way through the session. If you would like your food delivered to your room at this time,

please make sure you have rented the room accordingly. Room rental for each additional hour is \$50.00.

6. Can you hold/store my gifts and/or food?

The facility cannot assume the responsibility for storing or watching gifts, decorations, and goodie bags. If you will be in need of a central storage or holding room, please rent the party room for the duration of the public skating session. Otherwise, we suggest you bring bags and have a designated adult watch your items.

7. Can I put my Ice Cream Cake and drinks in your freezer or refrigerator?

No, Montgomery County Health Department rules and regulations prevent us from storing food brought into the facility unless is food bought by us for resale delivered by certified food vendors.

8. How do I purchase admission and skates for my guests?

You can purchase admission and skate rentals on the day of your party up to one half hour prior to the start of the session at the front desk.

9. Are my guests required to bring/wear any type of protective gear?

No, but we do *recommend* that young guests wear a bicycle helmet and gloves and guests of all ages dress in layers (sometimes it gets cold out on the ice).
