

INFORMATION FOR PRIVATE LESSON STUDENTS

* Private lesson fees must be paid directly to each coach.

* In addition, all private lesson students must pay an ice fee directly to the front office.

* Students must sign in and ice fees must be paid to the front office *prior* to getting on the ice for the private lesson. Ice fees are as follows:

* <u>Public Session:</u>	Tot (ages 3-4)	\$3.50
	Child (ages 5-10)	\$5.50
	Regular (11 & up)	\$6.50
	Weekend (5 & up)	\$6.50
* <u>Freestyle/Dance:</u>	All ages	\$12.00

* Skate Rental, if needed: \$3.25

* Please refer any questions to the front office staff.

* Communication with your instructor is essential. If at any time you wish to take a break or switch instructors, please let your current instructor know immediately. They can help with the transition.

* Please contact the instructor directly.

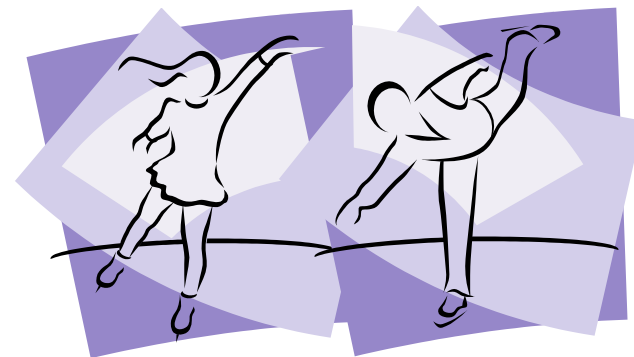
* Be sure to review with the instructor where to meet for your first lesson, as well as the instructor's private lesson fee and ice fee to be paid at the front desk upon arriving.

Looking for a Coach? Looking to add or change Coaches?

Wheaton Ice Arena and Cabin John Ice Rink coaches follow the standards set out by the Professional Skaters Association. In compliance with their stated Code of Ethics and Professional Conduct, it is against our policy for an instructor to solicit another instructors' students or teach other instructors' students without their consent.

If you have EVER contacted a private lesson instructor (now or in the past) and would like to make a change in your child's private lesson teacher or add an additional instructor to your child's ice skating lesson schedule, please adhere to the following rules:

1. NOTIFY the current instructor of your decision (and be sure you have paid any outstanding balances to the original coach).
2. CONTACT the new instructor regarding your interests.
3. THE NEW INSTRUCTOR must then contact the former instructor (even if the former coach is a contracted coach at another ice arena) to ensure their knowledge of the situation and then get back to the new student about their availability.
4. THE NEW INSTRUCTOR should not criticize the former instructor's teaching methods.

Solicitation will not be tolerated by coaches, parents, and/or skaters. If you feel you have experienced or witnessed solicitation at this facility, including 3rd party solicitation by parents, or if you hear or experience inappropriate criticism, please notify the rink management.
